Memorandum of Agreement

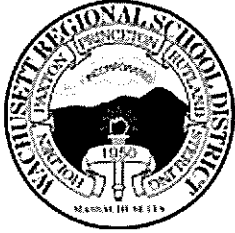
The undersigned, James M. Reilly, MSW, Ed.D, Superintendent of Schools for the Wachusett Regional School District, hereinafter the "District," and Linda Sasso, President, Wachusett Regional Education Association, Inc., hereinafter the "WREA," do hereby agree as follows:

Whereas it has been established there are two students with a serious medical condition who will need to be out of the school buildings, home-bound, for both extended and intermittent periods of time;

Whereas the Wachusett Regional School District administration has agreed to allow the use of remote access technology to facilitate the participation of two students in some classroom activities;

Now, therefore, the District and the WREA, for these two students only during this 2022-2023 school year, agree to the following:

1. The District shall provide the classroom teachers and said students with technology to establish a remote access connection between the home and the classrooms. The connection shall be used only for the purposes set forth in this agreement, and no other persons other than the home-bound student, their parents, and the assigned paraprofessional/tutor shall have access to the connections/view the remote broadcast.
2. The District shall set up and maintain said technology and provide training to the teacher for successful implementation of instruction through the use of said technology.
3. The home-bound students shall participate through the use of technology to interact with their classmates and provide access to classroom instructional activities as determined by the classroom teachers for social and academic purposes. From time to





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time, there may be the need to terminate the remote access feed for a short period of time-based on the teachers' discretion. Technology will be integrated into classroom instruction so that the impact on classroom instruction is minimal.

4. No other person(s), including, but not limited to, the District or any other District representative, any District employee, the home-bound student or their parent/guardian, or any other parents/guardians, will be allowed to record any classroom activity including video, audio, or any other form of recording.
5. The remote access feed shall not be used for the purpose of evaluation or discipline to the teacher.
6. The District will ensure that the remote access broadcast will only be received/viewed by the home-bound student, parent/guardian, and/or assigned instruction support staff at the location where the student is home-bound.
7. Any changes to this Memorandum of Agreement shall be negotiated between the WREA and the District. This MOA shall not establish any precedent.
8. The WREA member assumes no responsibility for the District obtained equipment beyond use for the educational purpose intended. The District assumes all liability in case of theft or damage during and beyond the school day/year.
